Dancin' Feet Dance School is a Nationally Accredited Dance School through Dance Masters of America and the National Clogging Organization. We are also affiliated with the Professional Dance Teachers Association and the Anoka County Arts Alliance. The school has large dance rooms equipped with quality sound systems, suspended maple sport wood floors, mirrors, ballet bars, and several observation windows. Classes are always open to parents for viewing. There is also a family friendly waiting and reception area. Dancin' Feet is proud to offer a family friendly environment, where classes are organized, fun, and educational. We strive to make Dancin' Feet a place where dancing includes technically correct and positive instruction, clean, age-appropriate music, costumes and movement. The training, experience, integrity and Christian values of our staff lend to the quality and excellence of our program. We are a recreational, educational and performance dance school where trained instructors are excited, knowledgable, and positive about teaching dance. At Dancin' Feet Dance School you will find a superior classroom environment, exceptional service, clean, first class facility and an organized, professional staff.

Dance Classes

Classes are taught in Tap, Jazz, Ballet, Irish, Hip Hop, Lyrical, Clogging and Exercise. Dancers age range from 18 months through Adult. Classes range from 30 minutes to one hour. Class sizes vary depending on the studio, dancer age and level. The average class size is 12 students. Class starts with a welcome time and warm-up followed by technique and dance instruction. Teaching aids are available for students along with technique progression and attendance that are recorded and rewarded in class. Each dancer has the opportunity to dance in two of our several spring shows. Class music and show costuming are tasteful and age appropriate. Class uniform is dance or workout wear and class specific shoe color and style. Spring shows are held in early May.

Staff

All of our instructors have extensive dance training and many class teaching hours. All have dance education and/or certification. All staff continues to update their training and take continuing education classes pertaining to their specific field of dance. Dancin' Feet Dance School has been the only dance school in the state to offer Nationally Certified Clogging Instructors since 2002. Creative choreography and a love for children and dance are several of the noticable qualities of our staff. Our classes are geared to be productive, safe, fun and organized. All of the Instructional Staff have biography's that are available for you to review. Most of our instructors have been at the dance school for over 10 years. You will find our front reception staff is friendly and knowledgeable.

Performance Teams and Opportunities

Dancin' Feet Dance School offers performance teams to students who want more than a weekly dance class. Performance teams are fun, non-competitive, community service, and special event dance groups. Dancers take a team class along with a regular weekly dance class. Teams will perform for numerous local events. They do several charity benefit performances, perform at nursing homes, malls, and community events. Performances are usually one Saturday a month starting in October and ending in April. All dancers may also have opportunities to travel and perform. Specialty Performance teams have performed at the Target Center, Super Bowl, Mall of America, Sydney Australia Summer Olympics, Six Flags, Nashville, Las Vegas, Disney World and the summer of 2010 in Branson. Special clinics and professional workshops are also offered throughout the year.
